Tennis Tip By: Kris Stofey, USPTA, Director of Tennis

I have had a few players recently ask me about learning the drop shot. One of my first responses is asking them if they will really take the time to practice it on their own before expecting to use it during a match. IT REQUIRES A LOT OF PRACTICE!

Also, one must have a basic concept of applying backspin – the opposite of topspin – to the ball. Once you have the feel of approaching the ball from “high-to-level”, you can BEGIN to learn the drop shot.

It can be helpful to use the ball machine (best after a lesson on the shot), in order to repetitively practice the shot.

In addition, there is a misconception about the height of the ball as it crosses the net. The ball should have good height as it crosses the net, but, should land two feet or less from the net. It is apparent why this shot is categorized as a “finesse” shot, and why it requires A LOT OF PRACTICE.
